Respondent Marc L. Williams, MS, LPC, was the subject of a complaint in which it was alleged that he violated several provisions of the ACA Code of Ethics. Respondent made an unintentional error in disclosing sensitive information to a minor client and then failed at first to notify the child's parents of the disclosure. This conduct is in violation of Section of the ACA Code of Ethics. Based upon his admissions, the Board finds probable cause to believe that respondent had violated provisions of the Code of Ethics for Licensed Professional Counselors.


Counsel for the Board and Respondent, having discussed the matters at issue in this case with each other and Counsel for the Board with her client; and it further appearing that it would serve the ends of justice that a Consent Order be entered which will resolve this matter, and to that end, with the consent of all parties, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

IT IS, BY CONSENT, HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED;

1. Respondent is to work under a Board Approved Supervisor for a period of six months from the date of this order, with a focus on honesty in the practice of counseling.
2. The Supervisor will file a supervision report monthly. The report is to contain verification of the hours of supervision.
3. The supervision required will be in the discretion of the supervisor, but not less than a minimum of one (1) hour of supervision for every forty (40) hours of client contact.

4. Respondent shall maintain all required CEU's for his renewal.
5. Respondent shall abide by the ACA Code of Ethics.
6. Failure of Respondent to abide by the terms of this agreement can be grounds for further disciplinary action by the Board upon a showing of probable cause and due notice to Respondent.
